Surface Prep

Thoroughly clean the surface and allow to dry. Remove wallpaper and loose, peeling paint. Scrape and sand peeled or damaged paint. Sand glossy surfaces dull. All dust should be removed. Heavily stained areas, including tannin stains on wood, may require an appropriate stain-blocking primer. For damaged drywall paper: If only the drywall paper was damaged, remove any loose paper and then use 80- 120 grit sandpaper to lightly sand the area to help feather the edges where the paper was removed and then apply a uniform coat of Wall-Repair Sealer to the damaged area. Allow 3 hours drying time before applying a skim coat, patch, wallcovering, or primer. For gouged and damaged drywall: Remove any loose chunks. Apply a uniform coat of Wall-Repair Sealer to the damaged area. Allow 3 hours drying time before applying a patch or skim coat. Once dry and sanded smooth, the patched or skim coated areas should be primed again with Wall Repair Sealer or other appropriate Dutch Boy® primer.</p> <p>Clean Mildew From the Surface: Mildew is a fungus that looks like dirt, but won't wash off. Mildew must be removed before painting or it will grow through any new coat of paint. To remove mildew or suspected mildew, scrub surface before painting with a commercial mildew remover or a solution of 1 part liquid chlorine bleach to 3 parts water. Rinse thoroughly. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Protect skin and eyes by wearing rubber gloves and eye goggles when working with bleach solution.</p>

Application

Application: Stir primer thoroughly before and during use. Apply with a nylon/polyester brush, pad applicator, synthetic roller or airless sprayer. If applying by sprayer, back-roll or back-brush to work primer into the surface. Apply a liberal coat of primer uniformly, working well into the surface. Appears milky during application, but will dry clear. Must be topcoated within 14 days with architectural latex or oil finishes or wallcovering.

Clean Up/Disposal

Cleanup/Disposal: Clean up with warm, soapy water. Do not pour unused contents down the drain. Consult with local authorities for proper method of disposal and recycling.
