SURFACE PREPARATION

Remove surface contaminants with an appropriate cleaner, rinse thoroughly and allow to dry. Remove peeled or damaged paint. Sand glossy surfaces dull. Seal stains with the appropriate primer. New/Unpainted Surface: New, bare and badly weathered wood should be primed with an exterior oil or latex primer. New or bare metal should have all surface rust removed and then primed with an appropriate metal primer. Previously Painted Surfaces: Scrape off loose and peeling paint, sand, then prime. Hardboard Siding (unprimed, primed or previously painted): Remove any wax from bleed-through areas by wiping with mineralspirits-soaked rags, turning often to avoid merely spreading wax around. Prime all hardboard with an exterior oil-based primer. Masonry: Wire brush loose material from chalking areas on concrete, brick and concrete blocks. Prime with an exterior latex primer. Metal: Remove rust on galvanized surfaces and spot-prime with a rust-inhibitive metal primer.
