## WHERE TO USE

Properly prepared durable textured or plain interior ceilings including previously painted and primed plaster, drywall, acoustical tile and wood.

## SHIPPING & PACKAGING

## Freight Classification:

Paint or paint related material. Protect from freezing.

## **APPLICATION**

Stir paint thoroughly before and during use. Intermix containers for uniformity. Apply product when surface, air and product temperatures are between 50-90°F. Apply with a premium-quality brush, roller or airless sprayer. Thinning not required. Certain deep or bright colors may require an additional coat for complete hide. Surface conditions and application technique may impact coverage.

### **Brush**

Use a premium-quality nylon or polyester brush.

#### Roller

Use a premium-quality synthetic, 3/8 - 1/2" nap roller.

#### Spray—Airless

# **CLEANUP/DISPOSAL**

Clean up with warm, soapy water. Do not pour unused contents down the drain. Consult with local authorities for proper method of disposal and recycling.

## SURFACE PREPARATION

### General:

Thoroughly clean the surface and allow to dry. Remove wallpaper and loose, peeling paint. Patch cracks and spot prime. Remove gloss from shiny surfaces.

## **Acoustical Tile:**

Vacuum or dust tiles to remove embedded dust. To maintain the sound absorbing qualities of the tile, do not use a primer. Apply ceiling paint directly to the tiles. Test vinyl-coated tiles to ensure adhesion. Do not attempt to fill or clog acoustical perforations.

"Blown-on" Soft-Fibered Ceilings: Caution! All water-based paints will loosen or deteriorate a "blown-on" soft-fibered ceiling surface and make for a difficult repair. If you are not sure about your ceiling texture type, apply a small test area in a closet or other hidden spot. If deterioration occurs and if painting is necessary, priming with an oil-based primer may help minimize the deterioration. Do not use a latex primer.

Clean Mildew from the Surface: Mildew is a fungus that looks like dirt but won't wash off. Mildew must be removed before painting, or it will grow through any new coat of paint. To remove mildew or suspected mildew, scrub surface before painting with a commercial mildew remover following manufacturer's safety instructions.
