## APPLICATION

Stir paint thoroughly. Intermix containers to ensure uniform colour. Apply with a premium- quality roller or polyester brush. Two thin coats are required. Bare wood and some deep or bright colours may require an additional coat to obtain complete hide. Surface conditions and application technique can also impact coverage. Allow to dry thoroughly before recoating or use.

Thoroughly clean the surface and allow to dry. Remove all dirt, dust, chalk, rust, grease, wax and mildew. Scrape off loose and peeling paint. Dull glossy surfaces by sanding.

#### Metal:

Remove all oil, grease, dirt and oxidation from surface. All bare metal surfaces should be primed with a rust-inhibitive metal primer
