GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Valspar Metal Building Roof & Siding Finish restores old, weathered metal siding and roofs to a beautiful appearance and protects against rust. This premium water reducible acrylic formula dries quickly to a long lasting, durable, fade and chalk resistant semi-gloss finish. Cleans up easily with soapy and water. Ideal for sloped metal roofs and vertical metal siding on sheds, outbuildings, barns and pole buildings. Use as-is for a "Direct to Metal" (DTM) product or use with Valspar Rusty Metal Primer over corroded metals.

RECOMMENDED USES

Properly prepared, sloped, exterior-metal roofs and vertical-metal siding including steel and galvanized raised ridge. Suitable for wood siding too. Not intended to fix leaking roofs; not for use on flat roofs or nonmetallic roofing materials. Ideal for metal barns, sheds, exterior walls, trim and doors, aluminum siding and mobile homes.

APPLICATION

Stir paint thoroughly. Intermix containers to ensure uniform color. Apply paint with an airless sprayer. Work quickly as paint dries fast on roofing surfaces. Premium-quality polyester brushes and rollers may be used for small or difficult-to-spray areas. Apply 2 coats to all surfaces; allow to dry overnight between coats. When applying to raised ridge or other directional surfaces, spray the second coat from the opposite side of the first to ensure complete coverage.

Brush: Premium-quality polyester **Roller:** Premium-quality roller 3/8–1/2" nap

Thinning: Thin only for spray application with up to 8 oz. of water per gallon of paint (236 mL per 3.78 L).

SURFACE PREPARATION

General:

Read the Lead Warning paragraph. Thoroughly clean the surface and allow to dry. Inspect roof and siding seams for leaks and make repairs with appropriate paintable patching material. Remove all wax, grease, dirt, chalk, mildew, loose and peeling paint, rust and other foreign matter. New or bare surfaces should be primed with an appropriate Valspar® primer.

Mildew:

Mildew is a fungus that looks like dirt but won't wash off. Mildew must be removed before painting or it will grow through any new coat of paint. To remove mildew or suspected mildew, scrub house before painting with a commercial mildew remover or a solution of 1 part liquid chlorine bleach to 3 parts water. Rinse thoroughly. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Protect skin and eyes by wearing rubber gloves and eye goggles when working with bleach solution.

Wood/Bare Wood:

Remove sap from knots and sappy areas. Spot prime knots with a Valspar® exterior oil-based primer. Then prime new or bare surfaces with a Valspar® exterior latex or oil primer.

Ferrous Metal (Steel and Iron):

Hand or power tool clean steel to remove loose mill scale and rust. For large areas, cleaning is most effective with a power washer. Remove oily residues and contaminants with solvent or appropriate cleaning solution. Change rags often, to assure that residual contaminants are completely removed. Prime with Valspar® Armor Anti-Rust Primer.

Galvanized Metal and Aluminum:

Allow new galvanized metal to age six months or clean with mild muriatic solution. Metal should be free of oils and other contaminants. Prime with Valspar® Armor Anti-Rust Primer.
