APPLICATION

Application: Stir paint thoroughly. Intermix containers to ensure uniform color. Apply when air, surface and product temperatures are above 50°F. No reduction necessary. If applying by spray, back-rolling is recommended for drywall, plaster, and masonry.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface should be clean, dry and dull. Remove all contamination by washing with an appropriate cleaner, rinse thoroughly and allow to dry. Scrape and sand existing, peeling or cracking paint to a sound surface. Sand glossy surfaces. Drywall: Fill cracks and holes with spackling compound and sand smooth. Joint compounds must be cured and sanded smooth. Remove sanding dust. Masonry: Allow to cure at least 30 days. Remove all form release and curing agents. Rough surfaces can be filled to provide a smooth surface. If painting cannot wait 30 days, allow surface to dry 7 days and prime with Pro-Hide® Masonry and Stucco Primer. Plaster: Allow to cure at least 30 days. Treat textured, soft, porous or powdery plaster with a solution of 1-pint household vinegar to 1 gallon of water. Repeat until the surface is hard, rinse with water and allow to dry. Wood, Hardboard, Paneling: Sand bare wood to a fresh surface. Patch holes and imperfections with a wood filler and sand smooth. Remove sanding dust. Steel: Remove rust and mill scale with sandpaper, steel wool or other abrading method. Prime bare steel the same day as cleaned. Aluminum & Galvanized Metal: Wash to remove any oil, grease or other surface contamination using a water-based cleaner-degreaser. Do not use hydrocarbon solvents for cleaning. Remove all corrosion with sandpaper, steel wool or other abrading method. PVC Piping: Lightly scuff sand the surface for best adhesion..
